perceiving and recognizing and understanding the wonders of His Person more strongly and more clearly,


and that I may in that same way come to know the power outflowing from His resurrection which it exerts over believers,


and that I may so share His sufferings as to be continually transformed in spirit into His likeness even to His death.

...that I may in that same way (progressively and intimately) come to know...



and that I may so share His sufferings as to be continually transformed in spirit into His likeness even to His death.


