




Reordering through Simplicity


Everything around us works against reordering and simplifying our lives.






Clutter = to clot

What is required?






James 4:8

Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even <u>thinking</u>.




Instead, fix your attention on God.You'll be changed from the inside out. Readily recognize what he wants from you, and quickly respond to it.
